### Top tips on how to be safe online.

**Don't give out your personal information** – Don't put personal details such as your home address, telephone numbers or parent's work address online as cybercriminals can use this information to create a profile with your details

**What goes online, stays online** – Use privacy settings to make sure only your friends and family can see the photos you post. Don't post holiday plans.

**Password safety** – Sharing your password with your parents is a sensible idea, but don't share your password with your friends, even if they promise they won't tell anyone! Also, when setting your password, make sure it isn't something people may guess such as your pet's name. Use a mixture of letters, numbers and upper and lower case characters.

**Don't talk to strangers online or offline** – Don't meet up with strangers. Let your parents know if a stranger has tried to get in contact with you online. Often people you speak to online may not be who they say they are, so only share your personal details on social media sites with friends, family and people you already know in the 'real' world.

**Be careful what links you click on** – Avoid clicking links in an email, Instant Message or on your social network unless you are sure the message is from someone you know. Cybercriminals hack into your friends' email accounts and social networks to send emails or post messages claiming they are in trouble and asking you to transfer money for them. Don't trust them and be very careful.
